Provide contact details

You must inform the school immediately of any changes to your contact details.

Important: Correct information (child's date of birth, telephone number) must be provided if you are to retrieve your child's test results.

Testing procedure at school

A pool PCR sample and an individual PCR sample will be obtained from your child at school and sent to the laboratory.

Test result – pool

You will receive an **SMS notification** to the mobile number provided only in the event of a **positive** pool result in your child's class. This notification is usually sent by the laboratory by **9.30 pm** on the day of testing. Your child's individual PCR sample will then be processed.

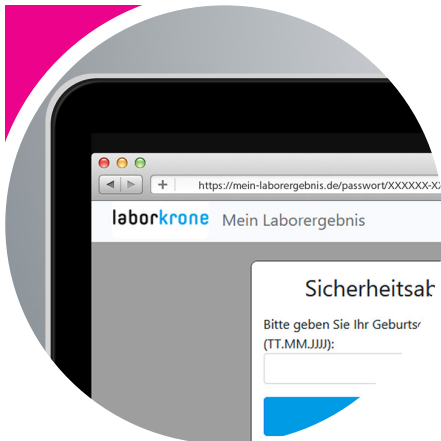

Test result – individual PCR

You can retrieve your child's individual PCR test from **6.00 am** the following day at the latest. As soon as your child's results are available, you will receive a second **SMS notification** with a link to the test result.

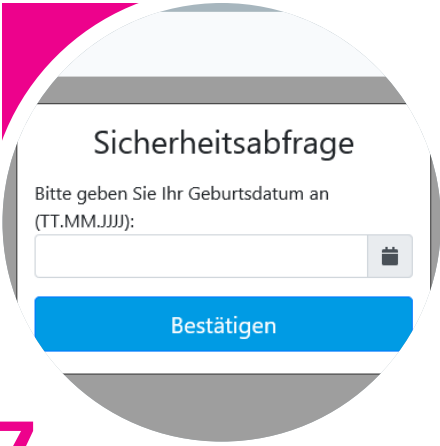


Online test result

Clicking the **link** will automatically open the results retrieval page.

If the page does not open, you can also type in the **full** URL and open it in another browser.

In the next step, enter your child's **date of birth**.

Click on "**Bestätigen**" (Confirm)

The PDF file showing your result should now be available for download.

Bring proof of testing

Only children with a negative individual PCR test result are allowed to attend classes. Make sure your child brings proof of their negative result to school.

What happens in the event of a positive test result?

In the event of a positive result, your child should avoid all contact with other people. Your local health authority will also be made aware of the positive result and will contact you automatically. If you have any questions, please contact the class teacher or school coordinator.

What if...?

- **... there is no mobile number on file for me?**

Your school can provide a mobile number for your child and keep you informed of the status of the sample.

This is permissible under the coronavirus regulations in place in North Rhine-Westphalia (CoronaBetrVO NRW).

- **... the school cannot store a mobile number for my child?**

The school will receive a list of results of all children by 6.30 am on the day following pool testing. If your child has tested positive, this result will be available to your school.

- **... my child's result cannot be retrieved despite entering the correct date of birth?**

Ensure that your Internet browser is up to date or try again with a different browser or device. If the date of birth is showing as incorrect, please contact your school.

- **... my child's result is not available within the specified period?**

Delays can occur in rare cases, e.g. if the sample needs to be re-processed.

In all cases, a notification will be sent to the mobile number on file and to the school as soon as the result is available. Your child may return to school only if they receive a negative result.
